
They have accomplished many wonderful things, all embedded in our Mission Statement of being men and women of conscience, character, and compassion. Our school is a far better place because of them.

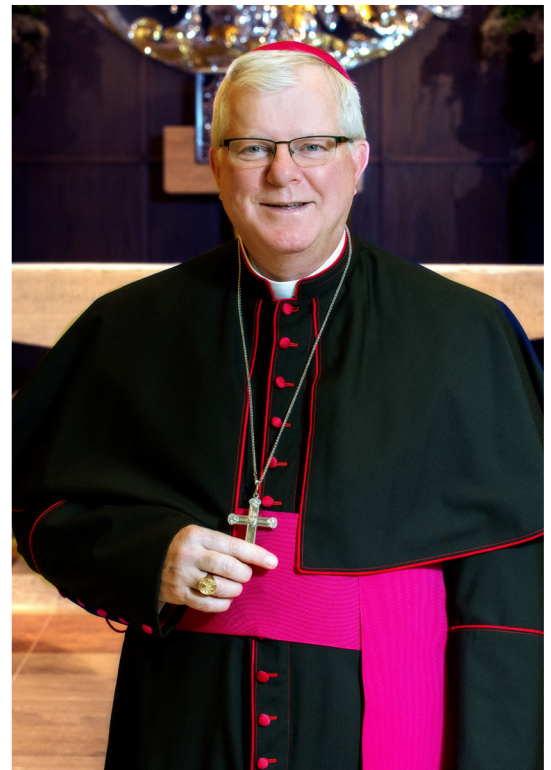

# FROM THE BISHOP



Every year about this time when a new school year was approaching and summer was drawing to a close, our parents were in the proximate mode of preparing for a new school year. My sisters were being outfitted for new uniforms, my brother and I sported new slacks, and a brand new white shirt and school regulated tie. We were not big fans of the Labor Day weekend, as it signaled the beginning of a new school year, and the end of summer vacation.

But there was one thing that was the tell-tale sign of the beginning of a new year – the marble colored notebook. To be honest, there was a little excitement in acquiring the notebook. First, it had a new book smell to it – which lasted only for a time, but was still fragrant enough to give it a sense of something new. But the most exciting (honest) part of getting our new notebook was in the first opening of its cover and pages. It was new, after all, so when you opened the book, there was a crackling sound of the pages opening up, and how they were sewn together, revealing clean and crisp pages that by year's end would be filled with words and sentences, doodles along the margins, graffiti born of boredom in class, and worn corners. I'd like to think that my notebooks, at year's end, were replete with knowledge acquired, so much so that when a full academic year was complete and the notebook was full, one would treat it like a treasure, and place it ceremoniously on the bookshelf in our room for future reference, but that wasn't always the case. I don't have any of those used books anymore, proof that what was once new and crisp and clean, ended up cast aside along with how it made me feel back in August when our parents returned from the store with new ones.

They still make those books, by the way, you can find them in a myriad of stores. When I catch sight of them, I am brought back to those early school days, and the clean look, the fresh smell, the crisp sound of the first opening. These things remind me of beginnings, especially the start of a new school year. But they also remind me of the newness in me, and how in my developmental stages, at this time of year, I too was filled with excitement from within as I faced a new year, a new beginning, with all that came with the start of school.

In my sentimentality, as a pastor, and now as bishop, I love this time of year – the first day of school, the new uniforms, the clean shirts and ties, the seemingly cumbersome book bags which contain some semblance of the marble copy books. I am also aware that our students of whatever age are either beginning or continuing a journey in life that leads them forward to some really exciting things.

I'd like to think that we, as their pastors, their teachers, their parents especially, join together with them as they take one more step in their education, and we pray, one more step in their lives of faith. My prayer is that at year's end they may discard their torn and tattered copy books, but that when the school year gives way to spring and summer next year, they will be that much closer to the Lord because of how this new beginning was accompanied by their growth in faith and in their relationship with the Lord. I don't think they can do this without us, in fact, I know they cannot. So what do you say, as we help prepare those young ones, the ones entrusted to our care, as we prepare them for a new beginning – we too see this time of year as a new beginning for those of us whose copy books of years ago are long gone, but whose faith has grown with the turning of each page.

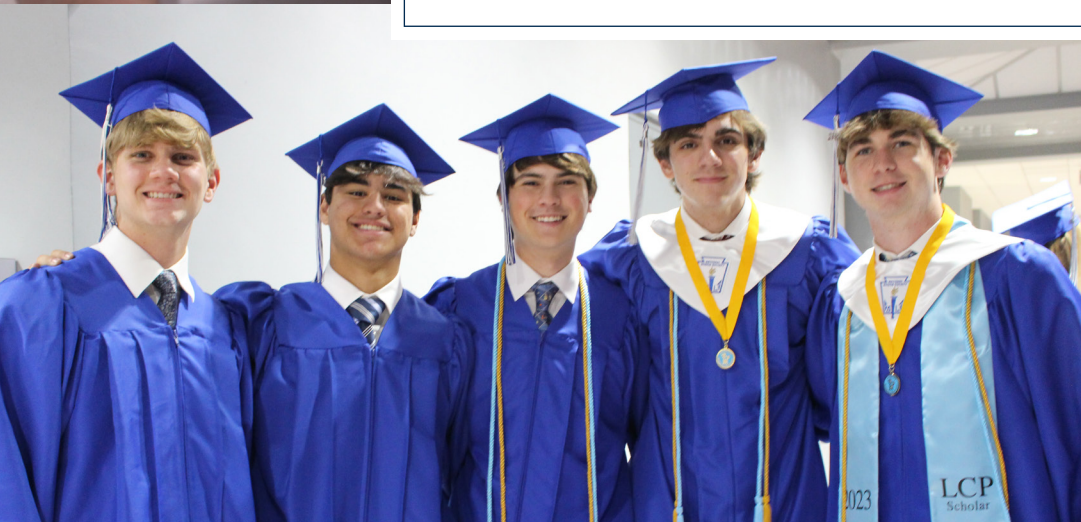
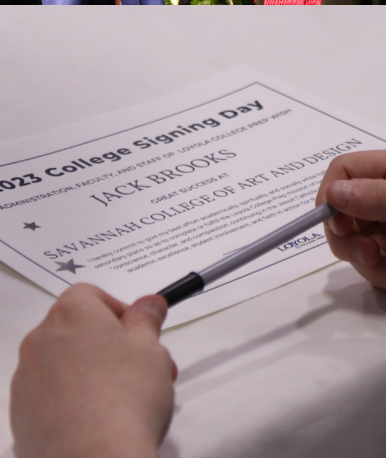
# Loyola College Prep Class of 2023

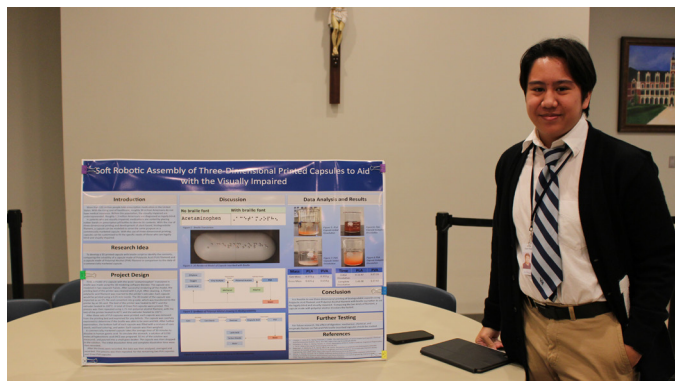

Loyola College Prep offers many different ways for students to prepare for college (it's in our name after all!). From learning how to study for exams, to managing their time, to engaging in high-level courses and projects, our students are ready for the next level of education after they graduate.

Many students, however, are literally taking college courses with our dual enrollment program and or earning college credits through our AP courses.

"We are proud to provide our students with 10 Dual Enrollment courses and 15 Advanced Placement courses at Loyola," Stephanie Johnson, Assistant Principal of Academics, said.

Dual Enrollment courses are offered through Louisiana State University at Shreveport (LSUS). Select courses are eligible for dual enrollment credit provided that teachers meet the criteria determined by the Louisiana Board of Regents.

Unlike College Prep classes, Advanced Placement courses at Loyola are much more rigorous and demand a higher level of performance both in and out of the classroom. The AP program offers students the opportunity to pursue college-level courses and potentially earn college credit while still in high school.

We are so proud of Father Kelby Tingle!







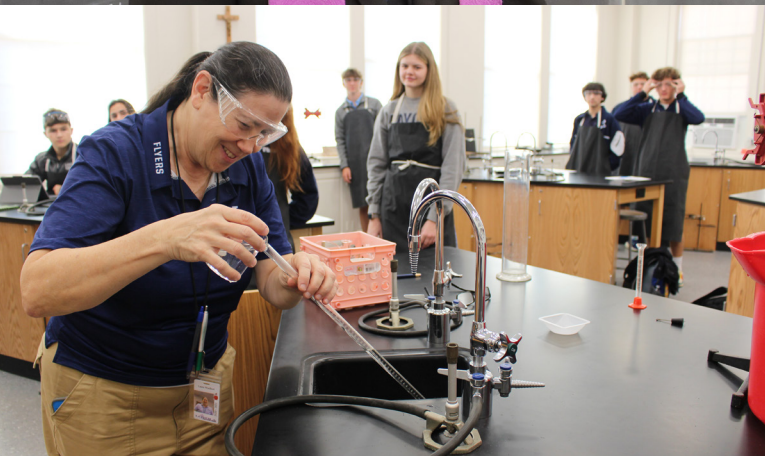
# CHEMISTRY LAB BACK IN ITS ELEMENT

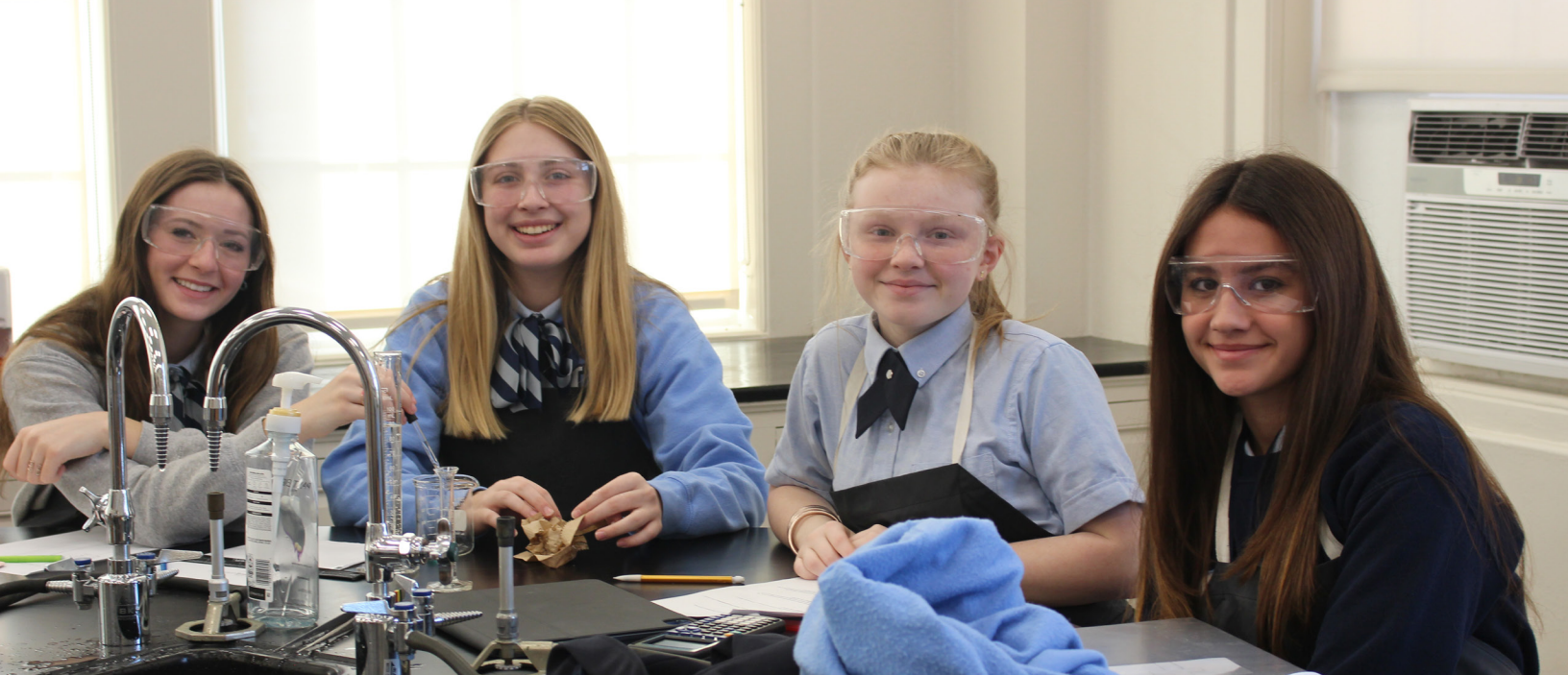
"This project was inspired by Father Horseman, a previous chemistry teacher from the Jesuit days and generously funded by the Zadeck family and donors from our inaugural Flyer Giving Day," said John LeBlanc, Principal.

The Zadeck family brought the idea to Mr. LeBlanc because they wanted to honor Father Horseman, he immediately started identifying contractors, worked with Mrs. Laura Woolbert on her input, and met with Jessica Ray, Advancement Director, on how to raise the remaining funds for the lab.

"It was not a question that we would include the chemistry lab as our special project for our first Flyer Giving Day," Ms. Ray said. "Our donors







loved the idea and really ran with it - especially our parents. They want to give their money to something that will directly impact our students, and this project is a true testament to that."

Flyer Giving Day 2021 donors raised over \$40,000 for the project and were all invited to a special open house and blessing for the space in October 2022.

The lab now features customized lab tables that each have their own sink, electrical outlet, and gas line. It was important to Coach Woolbert for the lab to have a mix of old and new items.

"We don't want to forget the legacy Father Horseman left on our school, so you can see that we kept these beautiful built-ins, some of the old glassware they used for lab experiments, and I even

kept this poster because it's silly and fun."

The students love the new lab and it is utilized to its full potential for Coach Woolbert's classes as well as other teachers who might want to use the space for a special project or lesson.

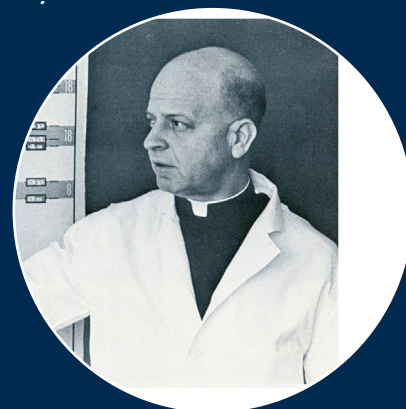

- Father Horseman was a chemistry teacher at Jesuit for 17 years (1958-1974)
- Only two Jesuits Priests were faculty members at the school longer than he was.
- He was the son of immigrant German baker and a New Orleans native.
- He was known for being a strict and for saying "you damn fool" to students.
- He was born on August 5, 1918 and died on November 4, 1993.
- He is buried in the Jesuit cemetery at Spring Hill College.

# Flyers on Track For State

A few years ago, not many associated success with the Loyola track program. For decades, there wasn't even a track team at all.

Once it returned, the progress was slow.

But under the direction of coach Sherrod Lewis, the Flyer track and field program is making some serious noise these days.

A 2014 graduate, Lewis was a multi-event participant in the track program Loyola in both the field and running events. He is now in his third year as head track coach and also serves as an assistant football coach.

Last year, the boys won the first district championship in school history. A year ago, the girls won the first regional meet. In 2023, 11 school records were broken.

Loyola was well represented at the state meet, highlighted by junior Tripp Roemer winning the 3200 and placing second in the 1600.

"I feel like my job is to make these students better athletes," Sherrod says. "Whether their main sport is track or they use the skills they learn here in their primary sport, I want them to succeed. I take a lot of pride in our athletic program at Loyola, and I am certainly proud to see how much these students achieve."

As the Flyers continue to make their mark at meets, Lewis says it doesn't come as much of a surprise.

"For the kids who have been with me for two or three years, I'm not surprised because I've seen them put in the work," he says. "But the ones I get as late bloomers, that's a huge surprise to me."

He says winning the girls regional a year ago has been the highlight of his coaching career, but that's not what it's all about.

"Just seeing the kids having fun whenever they win trophies or medals," he says. "It's the excitement they get whenever they win an event or a race. It's all for them. That brings a smile to my face."





# FLYER ALUM TAKES OVER AS HEAD BASEBALL COACH

One of the most accomplished players in Loyola baseball history is returning to become the next head coach of the Flyers. Morgan Brian '08, who re-wrote the school record book during his playing career, was selected to take over the program.

"I'm extremely blessed, excited and grateful to go back to the school where I played and help grow the program," Brian said. "That's what makes it so special. That means everything to me."

Brian is a three-time All-District player for Loyola from 2006-08 and was named to the Class 2A All-State team in 2008.

More than a decade after completing his career, Brian is still the school leader in career home runs (20), RBI (131) and total bases (237). He is the only player in school history to hit 10 home runs in a season. Following his outstanding career with the Flyers, he went on to play at Centenary College.

He has been involved in coaching baseball in the Shreveport area for the last 10 years. He has served as an assistant coach at Southwood and been involved in private instruction for beginner and college-level athletes. He has served as co-owner of Swamp Donkey Baseball, a youth baseball organization based in Benton.

Brian will take over a Flyer team that graduated only three seniors in 2023 but made its 29th consecutive playoff appearance.

"You want to have kids who do things the right way, not just with baseball, but also the school and the community," Brian said. "I am committed to building a program that follows the school's mission of creating men of conscience, character, and compassion."

With the addition of Brian, Loyola now has eight former Flyer athletes serving as head coaches.

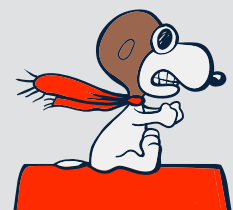

# BILLY THOMAS '94

There's no shortage of accomplishments for Billy Thomas in his basketball career. As a member of Loyola's Class of 1994, he's the greatest player in school history with school records that still stand today. He's the only Flyer to be named the Outstanding Player on an All-State basketball team.

He went on to star at Kansas, one of the legendary programs in college basketball, and set a record for most 3-pointers in school history on Jayhawk teams that were consistently ranked among the top team in the country.

From there, he had an 11-year career in pro basketball, including three stops in the NBA.

But what he takes the most pride in are the lessons he learned at Loyola.

***What can you bring to the team setting of whatever sport it is that you play?***

"It may sound funny, but it really wasn't any basketball (advice)," Thomas says. "I had great coaches and great people around me who taught me the value of being a great person and a great teammate, more than just being a great athlete. I had some fabulous teachers and coaches who pushed me to be the best person I could be and the best student I could be before I was an athlete. I took those lessons to help me understand how important it was to be a really good person on top of being the best athlete I could be."

After his pro career ended, Thomas became a high school coach in the Kansas City area, first at The Barlow School and now at Rockhurst, an all-boys Jesuit school.

He's learned plenty of lessons as a player and a coach that don't really have much to do with shooting or dribbling.

"What can you bring to the team setting of whatever sport it is that you play?" Thomas says as his best advice to young athletes. "Focus on doing things for others, being a servant. I'm big on leadership; you can't have too many leaders on a team. And it doesn't have to be a senior. As soon as a freshman can learn about being a leader, they should go for it."

That's a lesson he learned at Loyola and one he still hits home today.

"When guys talk about what a good teammate I was or someone says I was their favorite player," Thomas says, "those are the type of things that really do it for me."
